### **Maine startup to establish high technology business headquarters and operations at former Naval Air Station Brunswick**

***December 15, 2010***

Resilient Communications Corporation announced today the selection of Brunswick Landing: Maine's Center for Innovation, at the soon to be decommissioned Naval Air Station Brunswick (NASB), as the site of its headquarters, technology operations and manufacturing center. Brunswick Landing was chosen for its high-quality facilities and the region's skilled workforce. The company will establish: a state-of-art Secure Data Center; Disaster Recovery Center; and a Composite Manufacturing Facility for self-contained secure Network Communications and Data Center platforms. The company has worked closely with the Midcoast Regional Redevelopment Authority (MRRA) to reach the agreement announced today.

"I commend Resilient Communications and the Midcoast Regional Redevelopment Authority for their partnership leading to this exciting announcement and the promise of 150 new jobs in the Brunswick area," said Governor John E. Baldacci. "The decision of Resilient Communications to locate their base of operations at Brunswick Landing is a testament to the talented workforce here in Maine and to the aggressive work of all the partners in the area to reinvigorate the economy of the region. I am particularly pleased that this newest company to locate at Brunswick Landing will complement other businesses in the area that are using composite technologies. A strong cluster of technology development is taking hold in the area which will benefit the economy of the entire State."

MRRA and Resilient Communications Corporation have entered into a long-term agreement to locate in two existing special purpose facilities - the former high security Fleet Communications and Information Processing Center (Wing Headquarters) and a high security Maintenance Facility (Fleet Services Unit). Resilient will reuse these unique assets to deliver private and secure network information services. The privately funded startup plans to invest several million dollars in facility enhancements to expand their capacity and adapt the facilities to new missions. The company expects to create over 150 high paying jobs as the facilities reach full capacity. Operations and facility upgrades are planned to begin early in 2011.

Resilient Communications Corporation is two year old company formed to develop and deliver innovative technical services and solutions in the cyber-security and network communications business sector. The company is led by experienced former Fortune 500 executives and veterans, a number of whom are native Mainers. The leadership team and technical staff have decades of experience at leading technology and communications companies, with broad experience in the commercial and government business sectors. The



company plans to team with other companies at Brunswick Landing and to leverage the rapidly developing center of excellence in composite manufacturing, training and production. The company hopes to contribute to the redevelopment of the former base by bringing cutting edge information technology innovation to Brunswick Landing, a critical resource for Maine's future.
