PORTLAND TOWER LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 11-1

SUBJECT: BRUNSWICK EXECUTIVE AIRPORT (KBXM)

CANCELLATION: December 15, 2011

This letter describes available frequencies and Air Traffic Control (ATC) services for the Brunswick Executive Airport (KBXM).

On April 2, 2011 Brunswick Executive Airport – KBXM, formerly known as NAS Brunswick - KNHZ will be open for general aviation use. The BXM airport UNICOM will be 122.725.

ATC services are available from Portland (PWM) Approach from 0545-2359 local on 125.5. Boston Center will provide service on 124.25 during the periods PWM is closed (0000-0545L).

Visual approaches will be available weather permitting. Instrument approach procedures are being developed for future publication. IFR departure clearances and cancellations may be requested through Flight Service (1-800-wx-brief).

Airport information is under development. Information will be updated as it changes via NOTAM. Please check Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) for updates via <https://pilotweb.nas.faa.gov> or contact Flight Service 1-800-wx-brief for the latest changes to this airport.

Use caution when arriving and departing to the south, Portland Class C airspace is approximately 10 miles from the airport. When arriving and departing to the north, there are 2 airports within close proximity to KBXM: IWI (Wiscasset Airport) and 08B (Merry Meeting Airport).
